## Guide to Finding Alumni to Join Your AEIF Team

Need help finding alumni to join your team? Here are some tips below. *Note:* in order to qualify for AEIF, your team must have five alumni members registered and approved on the International Exchange Alumni website ([alumni.state.gov](http://alumni.state.gov))

1. Use the [Alumni Directory](#) on the International Exchange Alumni website to search for alumni, or locate an [Alumni Association](#) in your country.
  - Log into the website, go to the [Network and Collaborate](#) tab and use the [Filter this List](#) feature to see a list of alumni from your country and/or exchange program.
